How Does NYSCEA Work?

NYSCEA is...

- » **A DELEGATE ASSEMBLY** consisting of two voting representatives from each member group which meets three times annually to discuss issues and make decisions which affect education at all levels of state government.
- » **AN EXECUTIVE BOARD** which includes the President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Past President and Committee Chairpersons who keep in contact with their team or committee members regularly, and make recommendations to the Delegate Assembly.

What Does NYSCEA Do When They Meet?

Each meeting consists of a presentation and collaborative session with NYS Education Department leaders, as well as an afternoon business meeting. Past presenters include the: *Commissioner of Education, Deputy Secretary of Education, Senior Deputy Commissioner of Education*, and many other Assistant Commissioners.

When & where does NYSCEA meet?

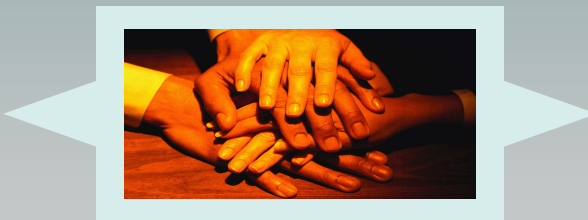
NYSCEA meets three times annually, typically in October, February and May at the Holiday Inn, Albany, on Wolf Road.
