SUBJECT: Adjustment to the Testing Schedule for the Grade 8 Intermediate-Level  
Social Studies Test Provided in Response to H1N1 Flu-Related School Closings

With the help of school officials, we have been closely monitoring the impact of the H1N1 flu. We understand that in a small number of schools the H1N1 flu is interfering with the administration of the June 2009 New York State Grade 8 Intermediate-Level Social Studies Test. Recognizing the needs of students, the Department is providing an adjustment in the scheduling of this test at the affected schools. Only those schools that experience an H1N1 flu-related closing for one or more days during the official testing period for the Grade 8 Intermediate-Level Social Studies Test, (June 2-9, 2009), may extend the test administration and makeup period for a maximum of five school days from the date that the school resumes classes following the school closing. All testing in the affected schools must be completed no later than Friday, June 19, 2009.
