# Next Generation Learning Standards and Assessment Timeline

The projected timeline for standards and assessments over the coming years is:

- **September 2017:** Adoption of Next Generation Standards
- **Awareness Building 2017-2018 School Year:** Two-day assessments measuring the P-12 CCLS standards; professional development on Next Generation Standards;
- **Capacity Building 2018-2019 School Year:** Two-day assessments measuring the P-12 CCLS standards; professional development continuing on Next Generation Standards;
- **Capacity Building 2019-2020 School Year:** Two-day assessments measuring the P-12 CCLS standards; professional development continuing on Next Generation Standards;
- **Full Implementation September 2020:** Full implementation of the Next Generation Standards;
- **Spring 2021:** New grade 3-8 tests measuring Next Generation Standards.

# Resources and Conferences

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- The first Next Generation Standards conference was held in Saratoga in November 2017 (1,000 educators attended)

# Roadmap: Suggested Goals & Activities for Rollout

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- The Roadmap is being developed in collaboration with BOCES District Superintendents, local school districts, NYSUT, UFT, the Staff & Curriculum Development Network, and other stakeholders
- Breaks down goals for the next three years of the Next Generation Standards Rollout
- NYSED will not oversee district activities from the Roadmap; districts determine their own action steps and specific goals
- Professional organizations are reflected as stakeholders and partners in the work

**Goal 1: Clearly communicate the adoption and the implementation timeline of the Next Generation ELA and Mathematics Standards**

**Goal 2: Understand and clearly communicate the changes between the NYS P-12 CCLS and the NYS Next Generation Learning Standards**

**Goal 3: Develop a P-12 district/building/grade level plan to be utilized in Phase II for curriculum development and professional development aligned to the NYS Next Generation ELA and Mathematics Learning Standards**

**Goal 4: Support the development of summative assessments at the State level aligned to NYS Next Generation ELA and Mathematics Learning Standards**

**Phase I: Raise Awareness**
